STATE OF MAINE.

Certificate of Organization of a Corporation, under Chapter Sixty-two  
of the Revised Statutes, and Amendments Thereto.

The undersigned, officers of a corporation duly organized at dwelling  
house of Mary Hayden in the town of Winslow, State of Maine, on the twenty-  
eighth day of April A.D. 1924, hereby certify as follows:

The name of said corporation is Fort Halifax Chapter, Daughters of the  
American Revolution.

The purposes of said corporation are: To perpetuate the memory of the  
spirit of the men and women who achieved American Independence, by the  
acquisition and protection of historical spots, and the erection of monu-  
ments; by the encouragement of historical research in relation to the  
Revolution and the publication of its results; by the preservation of  
documents and relics, and of the records of individual services of Revolu-  
tionary soldiers and patriots, and by the promotion of celebrations of all  
patriotic anniversaries.

To carry out the injunction of Washington in his farewell address to  
the American people, "to promote, as an object of primary importance, in-  
stitutions for the general diffusion of knowledge," thus developing an en-  
lightened public opinion, and offering to the young and old such advantages  
as shall develop in them the largest capacity for performing the duties of  
American citizens.

To cherish, maintain and extend the institution of American freedom, to  
foster true patriotism and love of country, and to aid in securing for  
mankind all the blessings of liberty.

To secure and hold real estate for any of the above mentioned purposes.
