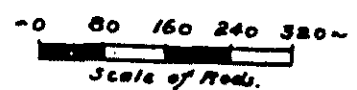

- These were the original Proprietors of the township which was incorporated in the year of our Lord A.D. 1771 by the name of Winslow.

February 14, 1818. The 50 acre lot No 66 was deeded Asa Burnham by John Drummond for 150 dollars for which Burnham gave his note # in number of \$37.50 each to Robert Drummond. This lot was given to Robert R Drummond by John Drummond his father as part of his portion. I made the deeds and witnessed the notes.
